

## Minutes of AGM 29/09/2022

Bob welcomed the members to the meeting.  
Nominations were requested for the positions on the committee.  
There were none.  
Jason asked the room to vote on keeping the committee as is.  
This was carried.

Jason shared with the meeting that there are currently 99 rules for the league.  
The rules proposed to amend, change or remove were.

2.7 Registration sheets.  
proposed that they be removed.  
The room voted against. The registrations sheets remain.

3.1. Start time.  
It was proposed the start time be changed.  
The room voted against. 9pm stands.  
However. If both teams are ready before this time the games may start if agreed.

3.2/3.3. late players.  
Proposed late player can be added to the team at any time.  
This was voted and carried.

3.4 Changing players  
It was proposed that this rule was removed.  
Subsequently a vote was taken to change this rule.  
This rule now reads. Any amount of players may be changed after each game has finished. The order of the players may be changed as well if wished.

3.7 This rule was clarified by the secretary to the members. And thus amended.

This rule now reads. Teams fielding only 6 players on the fours can choose to play **either** 2 teams of three players **or** 1 team of four and 1 team of two.  
The order of play shall be decided by the drawing of cards **only** if it decide to play a 4 and a 2.

3.11 Proposed to change to. 'if any games are not completed on the night, the final result will be decide by the committee.  
This was voted and carried.

4.4. New wording. 'teams should contact the committee immediately should they disagree with any proposed rescheduling of games.  
This was voted and carried.

5.5 It was proposed to change the rule to  
Photograph results and posted to the what's app group  
This was voted and carried.

6.5 It was proposed to change the draw time to 9pm.  
This was voted and carried.

6.8 It was proposed to remove this rule.  
This was voted and carried.

6.13. The word 'venue' was added to this rule.

6.14 The wording 'captains and secretaries must attend at least 2 quarterly meetings to qualify for the delegates cup' was added to this rule.

6.16. Chalking and calling..added the wording ' they may however nominate another person to take their place, should there be a reason to do so.

7.1. The wording 'should there be a summer cup' was added.

8.2 The wording 'sandwiches' was changed to 'food'

8.6 It was proposed this rule be removed.  
It was voted and carried

8.7 The wording 'paid' was changed to 'voluntary

8.22 It was proposed that this rule was removed.  
This was voted and carried.

End of rules.

AOB

A member suggested that the 8s competition be changed to best of 5 instead of 7.  
This was voted and declined.  
The 8s competition will stay at best of 7

Jason suggested that calling and chalking be shared if 1 team is short on players.  
This would be a gentleman's agreement

Jason welcomed the Henley Arms to the league.  
He also shared that the Abbey Arms were to leave the league,

The members joined Jason in wishing them well and hoping that they will return to the league when the time is right.

Royston and Bully were asked if they were happy to continue in their respective rolls. They replied that they were.

Jason emphasised that all decisions by the committee are final.

In respect to West Ham football games clashing with darts matches, they can be postponed due to players attending the football, however if you have enough players available that game should still go ahead, even if played at another venue.

Jason said that under no circumstances is the league to run into August next season. He confirmed that a team can play with 6 players.

Games that are postponed to another date due to football, if players fail to attend that game this will result in a 5-0 loss. Again these games can be played at another venue.

Jason is keen to introduce a 3s and 4s competition with £5 per team entry, The members agreed to this.

This is assuming the league finishes on time.

A balance sheet was requested from the treasurer by a member as stated in the Constitution 5.2.2. A sheet was circulated to some but not all members. The member noted that there were discrepancies in the layout and the figures ie. Totals did not add up and there were no incoming monies shown. This was not addressed by the treasurer and no reply was given. The balance sheet was not opened for general discussion at the meeting and therefore not ratified by the members.

### **Finally.**

Captains were asked to refrain from using the whats app group for general chatting. This group is **only** for results or anything relating to the league.
